## Storyword

Some of the words in the narrative below have been replaced with clue numbers. The missing words all fit into the grid opposite. For example, if the phrase is: 'Once 18A a time', this indicates that the solution to 18 Across is 'UPON', which can then be written into the grid.

Don't worry if you can't discover the precise word required at first glance – when more words are filled into the grid, the letters which intersect with others will help you discover further words.


Chapter 2 of *Treasure Island* by Robert Louis Stevenson:






## **Spiral Crosswords**



Solutions to this puzzle are only available in grid format.


## **Numbered Arroword**
